

Directions to Buscot Mill
Brandy Island
Buscot SN7 8DA



Please drive carefully down the narrow private road as you approach our business premises.

Buscot is an attractive little village on the fast A417 road between Faringdon and Lechlade-On-Thames.

If you come from Lechlade-On-Thames the village is on your left.

If you come from Faringdon the village is on your right.

You will see the ancient village hall (with a covered well and clock tower) as you turn into the village. There is a quaint tea shop on the right side of the road through the village.

Drive slowly directly through the village until you see the private track in front of you that leads down to the lock. The rather splendid Buscot Manor Guest house is on the left. You may use this private track to drive carefully to our site despite it saying no vehicular access - please show consideration for our neighbours.

You must have booked prior to arrival because it is a private track and the gates may be locked for security if we are not expecting you.

Drive down the track - it has stakes one side until it swings to the right with Lock House Farm ahead - SWING to the RIGHT and over the silver bridge - our own gates (White and open) are right in front of you and you will see the unmistakable pump station ahead to your left as you cross over the bridge - park up and we will meet you.



We are here - the track curves right here and we are over the bridge
